



The Rail Sector Deal is part of the UK's Industrial Strategy to strengthen the foundations of the UK economy. It aims to boost productivity to create good jobs throughout the UK





Rail Supply Group: Focus

WHAT?

A Rail Supply Group Coronavirus (COVID-19) Taskforce, has been formed with an agreed Terms of Reference

Supporting the rail supply industry to bounce back from the the current crisis

HOW?

Set out a clear path from the current crisis to achieve the fullest, fastest and best recovery for the rail supply industry

Rail Supply Group: Recap

- Conducted independent research– 442 responses: Published in June
 - 82% businesses confident about survival BUT
 - 56% if impact continues for 6 months
 - 24% if impact continues for 12 months
- We need to recover quickly to prevent wider impacts on cash flow, people, passengers, freight, skills and jobs.
- lack of demand and cash flow as being significant barriers for the recovery of their organisations to pre-virus levels

Rail Supply Group – 3 Act Now Priorities

- Improving work pipeline visibility: Working with industry partners, the RSG will complete expenditure analysis at contract level throughout the supply chain and highlight opportunities to accelerate work where it can be done productively.
- **Simplifying access to rail performance data**: The RSG will accelerate existing work by the Rail Data Council to simplify data access to allow better decision making in the short, medium and long term across all parts of the industry.
- **Changing railway access arrangements**: Working with industry partners, the RSG will explore whether access arrangements can be extended or enhanced forlarge projects or planned smaller projects to increase productivity.

Rail Supply Group – ACT NOW. Midland's Pilots

- SME resilience & growth through collaboration: Launching an OEM/ Asset Manager Accelerator; including reshoring, Covid-19 proofing (shortening the supply chain) and productivity.
- **De-carbonisation :** Working on second challenge with further clients hopefully for launch during August
- Schools Engagement: Accelerating the digital offering
