

Travel and Parking Update for UKRRIN / Birmingham Centre for Railway Research and Education (BCRRE)

As of Monday 9th May until Friday 23rd September, several of the larger car parks around the University of Birmingham campus are being closed and repurposed to stage events and support for the Commonwealth Games. This means that during a portion of this time, strict security cordons will be in place.

Please be advised that this means car parking spaces will have restricted availability. The North East Multi Storey and Pritchatt's Park visitor car parks will be open to visitors, but will be extremely busy.

We therefore advise that visitors use public transport where possible for a more convenient, comfortable and easy way to access the campus. The University rail station is a five-minute connection (two stops) from Birmingham New Street on the Cross-City line and is a short walk (one minute) to the UKRRIN and new School of Engineering Buildings. There is also a bus that serves the campus from the City Centre every ten minutes or so via the Bristol Road and Pritchatt's Road.

If you must bring a vehicle onto campus, please park in the following locations as vehicles in other locations without a staff permit will incur a £60 Penalty Notice:

**North East Car Park Multi Storey Floors 1-5 (access via Pritchatts Road)
Sat Nav Postcode B15 2SA**

The Ground Floor bays are reserved exclusively for Hotel Guests displaying a guest permit only.

Please note that this car park does not have a lift.

Pritchatts Park (next car park along after the closed Pritchatts Rd car park) B15 2QX

- 1-3 hours £4.00

Please be advised that enforcement procedures are in place in all University parking areas and penalty charge notices will be issued to all vehicles that fail to comply with University Traffic Regulations.
