UK railway suppliers are invited to join a joint Department for Business and Trade (DBT) and Railway Industry Association rail trade mission to the Train and Rail show held in Stockholm, Sweden on 25-27 April 2023.

On 24 April, a networking reception at the British Embassy in Stockholm is also being planned for participating companies and the Swedish rail industry.

This new railway-focused show is being coorganised by the Swedish Railway Industry Association (Swedtrain), providing a new meeting place for the industry. The trade mission is open to all UK companies.

Registration and Eligibility

- The event is open to all UK registered companies – a maximum of 2 delegates per company.
- Applications are open until full or Tuesday 4 April. Click the button below to register.

Main features/benefits of joining the trade mission

- Option to join the networking reception on 24 April 2023.
- Use of DBT's GREAT branded stand during the event as a place to hold meetings and display some of your company's literature.
- Receive market briefings from DBT's rail leads based in Sweden and Denmark.
- Use of DBT's meeting room during the duration of the show as a place to hold meetings.
- Join presentations from guest speakers including the Swedish Transport Administration.
- Further guest speakers to be added, dependent on the UK companies that register.
- Participation in 1-2-1 meetings with regional rail stakeholders - noting line-up dependent on the profiles of the UK companies likely to include participants related to infrastructure, rail systems, operations and OEMs/ maintenance.
- Support from DBT in being introduced to relevant market actors present at the show, as well as support from RIA's representatives at the event.

- Option to be added as a co-exhibitor on the DBT stand (an extra cost payable to the show organisers), to enhance profile, with improved visibility.
- Option to join the show's gala dinner (at an extra cost payable to the show organisers) and conference (may be in Swedish).

Costs, Travel

- Participation in the trade mission will cost £320 + VAT per company. 2 delegates maximum, 1st delegate will pay the mission fee, 2nd delegate is free.
- Mission delegates will need to cover their own travel and subsistence costs.
- Visitor tickets to the Train and Rail show are free of charge, but mission delegates will need to book the own entry badge.
- The exhibition is at the Stockholmsmässan exhibition centre, which can be easily reached by commuter train - from Stockholm Central Station to Stockholmsmässan takes just ten minutes.
